

Regulations for the Use of Collection Images

Individuals and organizations wishing to use images and other materials from the collection (hereinafter referred to as the "Images and Materials") of the Fukuda Art Museum (hereinafter referred to as the "Museum") are requested to apply upon agreeing to the following regulations.

Application Procedures

If you wish to use the Images and Materials, please fill in the required information on the designated Application Form for Use of Collection Images and submit it along with accompanying documents such as a project proposal. Upon acceptance of the application form, the Museum may issue a "Permit for Use of Collection Images and Invoice".

Precautions for Use

- Sublicensing, copying, replicating, or photographing without the prior approval of the Museum is strictly prohibited.
- When publishing the Images and Materials in print or broadcasting/streaming them on television or other media, you must explicitly state "Collection of Fukuda Art Museum".
- When using images, reproducing photographs from books, the Internet, or other unauthorized sources is prohibited. You must use the official images provided by the Museum.
- The use of the Images and Materials is limited to a single use per application. For secondary use, such as reprints, revisions, rebroadcasts, video/CD-ROM production, or Internet distribution, a new application must be submitted each time.
- If the Images and Materials are used in a publication, video, or similar media, please provide one copy of the final product to the Museum.
- Please make sure to delete all image data after use.
- For all other details regarding usage, please follow the instructions of the Museum staff.

Fees and Payment

The image usage fees for the collection materials are as follows:

Color image (per item)	: 10,000 JPY (excluding tax)
Monochrome image (per item)	: 6,000 JPY (excluding tax)
Administrative fee	: 3,000 JPY (excluding tax)

Depending on the purpose and method of use, the Museum may reduce or waive the usage fee if deemed appropriate. Please transfer the payment to the designated bank account within 30 days from the billing date, as per the invoice issued by the Museum. The applicant is responsible for any bank transfer fees.

If payment is not made by the due date without prior notice, a late fee may be charged.
