the exhibition room.



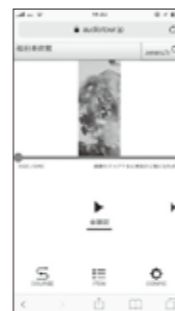
6 Select the number
