5 Select the exhibition room.



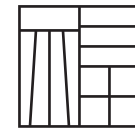
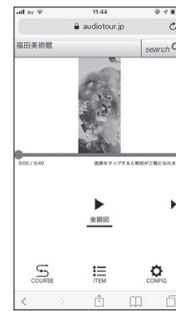
6 Select the number of the work of art and tap it.
